

TEXAS TWO YEAR COLLEGE ALL STATE CHOIR CODE OF CONDUCT  
Revised 2/11/2011

Each student who is certified to participate in the Texas Two Year College All State Choir must sign this form. It is understood by each student that any infraction of the rules of conduct constitutes grounds for dismissal from the All State Choir.

1. Students must wear name badges at all times in rehearsal as well as anytime in the hotel while outside the room.
2. Students must remain reasonably quiet at all times in the hotel. TV sets, radios, and tape players must be played with volume at low levels.
3. Hotel room doors should be shut and locked at all times.
4. Curfew for all students is midnight Wednesday through Friday nights. "Curfew" means in your own room.
5. Possession or use of alcoholic beverages or controlled substances will not be tolerated.
6. No singing or playing of instruments in the hotel after 9 p.m.
7. Every All-State Choir student is required to be on time for each rehearsal. "On time" is defined as present and seated with music folder in hand.
8. Hats, caps or chewing gum will not be allowed in rehearsals or performance.
9. Attendance will be taken at the beginning of each rehearsal and after each break and anyone not in attendance may be removed from the choir.
10. Every All-State Choir student is required to wear the appropriate dress for all rehearsals and the performance – including no showing of excessive skin or clavage. Normal school attire will be acceptable for all rehearsals. Dark suit (preferably black), white shirt and tie or tuxedo ensemble is appropriate concert dress for gentlemen. Floor-length black dress, skirt or slacks with black top shall be worn by ladies. Black dress shoes are the only appropriate concert footwear for all singers. Necklaces and dangling earrings are not allowed in performance; no facial jewelry of any kind may be worn.
11. Students must furnish a black vinyl 3 ring binder for music with a pencil enclosed.
12. Cell phone use during rehearsal is prohibited. Cell phones must be turned **off** prior to the beginning of rehearsal. Should the situation arise when a student needs to keep his/her phone on in order to receive an important call, they may leave their phone with their director or the choral coordinator. The student will be notified if/when the call comes in and they will be discretely excused from the rehearsal to attend to the issue at hand.

Signing this form indicates that it is understood by the students and directors that any infraction of the above rules of conduct constitutes grounds for dismissal from the Texas Two Year College All State Choir.
